<p>Apple Trees (<i>Malus domestica</i>)**</p> 	<p>An order consists of one "Red Delicious" and one "Granny Smith" Apple tree. The trees are bare root whips which are approximately 4' to 5' tall. Both varieties are well suited to the back yard grower. Red Delicious is the best early coloring super-red strain of Delicious. Granny Smith is a late, green, tart apple maturing in early November. It develops a red blush in the Northeast. Both are EMLA 111 rootstocks.</p>
<p>Peach Trees (<i>Prunus persica</i>)**</p> 	<p>An order consists of one "Coralstar®" and one "Messina®" Peach tree. Trees produce delicious fruit within a few years. Coralstar® holds well on the tree and does not brown when cut. Messina® is very vigorous & productive. Both are very firm with excellent color, flavorful and resistant to bacterial spot.</p>
<p>Persimmon (<i>Diospyros virginiana</i>)**</p> 	<p>An order consists of five Common Persimmon seedlings ranging in height from 12-18 inches. Persimmon are a native tree growing from 25-40 feet in height and 20-35 feet in width. Trees produce white, fragrant flowers that are very sweet and a favorite of honeybees in spring to yield an orange edible fruit in the fall that ripens after several frosts. More than one tree is needed for pollination to produce fruit.</p>
<p>Wild Black Cherry (<i>Prunus serotina</i>)</p> 	<p>An order consists of 5, 3 year seedlings, 1-3 feet in height. Grows to 60 feet. Grows well in a wide variety of soil types but grows best in rich, deep, moist soil. It has been highly prized in furniture making since colonial times and is an excellent firewood. Fruit provides food for many small animals.</p>
<p>Blueberry Bushes (<i>Vaccinium</i>)**</p> 	<p>An order consists of one "Sweetheart" (Early) and one "Aurora" (Late) blueberry bush obtained from a local berry farm. Plants are of bearing age and with care, will develop large flavorful berries. Select a sunny, well-drained site with sandy or loamy soil. You may need to add soil amendments.</p>
<p>Strawberry Plants (<i>Fragaria</i>)</p> 	<p>An order consists of 25 strawberry vine plugs. The flavorful variety is "Seascape" a productive day-neutral variety. Highly successful for Northeastern growers for summer and fall production. Seascape will flower and fruit all season. The berries are large, prolific, and have good flavor when picked ripe.</p>

<p>Douglas Fir (<i>Pseudotsuga menziessi glauca</i>)</p> 	<p>An order consists of 5, 2 year seedlings ranging in height from 12-16 inches. Douglas Fir is a splendid pyramidal evergreen conifer, with short stalked flat, dark green or bluish-green needles, ¾"to 1-1/4"long. Bears cones at maturity 2"-4" long. A rapid grower, hardy tree that grows well in a variety of soils. This Douglas Fir variety is Lincoln N.F. This strain is a good blue strain which buds late. Beautiful Christmas tree, a picturesque ornamental, or windbreak and can be sheared as a hedge.</p>
<p>Sugar Maple (<i>Acer saccharum</i>)</p>  <p>(fall color)</p>	<p>An order consists of 1 or 3 potted seedlings. They range in height from 12-15 inches. Native to northeastern United States. A good timber tree. Can grow to a height of 60-75 feet with a spread of 45-50 feet. Mature trees provide sugar products from sap in the spring. Does not do well in wet areas.</p>
<p>Astilbe</p> 	<p>An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Astilbes are perennial flowers that have plume-like flowers high above the deep green foliage. They brighten shady gardens with color. Colors vary but all are attractive to butterflies and beneficial insects. The glossy foliage resists diseases and pests including deer and slugs.</p>
<p>English daisy (<i>Bellis</i>)</p> 	<p>An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Bellis is a genus of flowering plants in the sunflower family. English daisy is a hardy biennial daisy that bear tightly double, quilled blooms in pretty shades of pink and white. They brighten up any garden.</p>
<p>Bellflower (<i>Campanula</i>)</p> 	<p>An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Bellflowers are a perennial flower that add great color to the mid-summer and fall garden after other flowers have finished blooming. Easy to grow and very cold hardy. They have bell shaped blooms. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.</p>
<p>Sweet Scabious (<i>Scabiosa</i>)</p> 	<p>An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Scabiosa is a genus in the honeysuckle family. It is a perennial that resembles a pincushion flower. Attractive to many pollinators and deer resistant.</p>
<p>Butterfly & Hummingbird Garden seed mix</p>	<p>Seed mixture is of native and naturalized wildflowers and grasses designed to attract nectar-loving pollinators such as native bees, insects and hummingbirds. Mixture is ERNMX-179. Majority of mix reaches 3-4 feet at maturity. Seed coverage : 7-10 pounds per acre; 1 ounce per 388 sq. ft.</p>
