Apple Trees (<i>Malus domestica</i>)**	An order consists of one "Initial™" and one "Gold Rush" Apple tree. The trees are bare root whips which are approximately 4' to 5' tall. Both varieties are well suited to the back yard grower. Initial™ is a scab-resistant variety that is a Gala x Redfree cross. Rootstock is Bud118. Gold Rush is best known for its remarkable keeping qualities. It resists oxidation when cut. Fruit is crisp and tart, develops sugars in storage. Root stock is EMLA-7.
Pear Trees (<i>Pryus</i>)**	An order consists of one "AC™ Harrow Sweet" and one "Bartlett" Pear tree. Trees produce delicious fruit within a few years. AC™ Harrow Sweet is a late season pear and is resistant to fire blight. Rootstock is OHxF97. Bartlett is large, heavy-bearing variety with excellent quality. Rootstock is Pyro 2-33.
Blueberry Bushes (<i>Vaccinium</i>)**	An order consists of one "Duke" (Early) and one "Bluecrop" (Mid) blueberry bush obtained from a local berry farm. Plants are of bearing age and with care, will develop large flavorful berries. Select a sunny, well-drained site with sandy or loamy soil. You may need to add soil amendments.
Strawberry Plants (<i>Fragaria</i>)	An order consists of 25 strawberry vine plugs. The flavorful variety is "Seascape" a productive day-neutral variety. Highly successful for Northeastern growers for summer and fall production. Seascape will flower and fruit all season. The berries are large, prolific, and have good flavor when picked ripe.
Norway Spruce Trees (<i>Pseudotsuga menziessi glauca</i>)	An order consists of 5, 3-year seedlings ranging in height from 10-18 inches. Norway Spruce is a fast-growing spruce tree that has short needles of a deep green color and beautiful spreading branches with drooping twigs. An extremely hardy tree that grows well in a variety of soils. A great Christmas tree, windbreak or ornamental.
Sundrop, Evening Primrose (<i>Oenothera</i>)	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Oenothera also known as Sundrop or Evening Primrose are perennial flowers that are valued for their showy, four-petaled, silky flowers. From late spring through summer they bear clusters of 1-2" wide yellow flowers that open in the daytime. Plants succeed in tough, rough places. Resist deer. Native to Eastern U.S.
Soapwort (<i>Saponaria</i>)	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Saponaria also known as Soapwort are perennial flowers from the carnation family that blooms May through September. Grows 1-2' tall and is a member of the pink family. It's easily grown in average, dry to medium well drained soil and fun sun. Deer resistant.
Balloon Flower (<i>Platycodon</i>)	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Platycodon, also known as Balloon Flower are perennial flowers. They get their name from the unopened buds that look like little balloons. It is a hardy, violet-blue flower that reaches a height of 1-3' and blooms throughout summer. They preform best in full sun or part shade and well-drained soils. Deer resistant.
Columbine (<i>Aquilegia</i>)	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Aquilegia also known as Columbine are perennial flowers that have attractive delicate, bell-shaped flowers and a wonderful lacy foliage that emerge early in the year and bloom for 4-6 weeks from mid spring through summer. They are a mix of colors, easy to grow and widely adaptable. Hummingbirds, butterflies and bees like them while they resist deer and rabbits.
Blazing Star (<i>Liatris</i>)	An order consists of 1 bag of 10 corms. Liatris also known as Blazing Star are perennial flowers that are native to North America. They are 1-5' tall plants that emerge from mounds of narrow, grass-like leaves. Liatris flowers form along the tall spikes, and these fuzzy, thistle-like blossoms, which are usually purple, flower from the top to the bottom rather than in the traditional bottom to top blooming of most plants.
Mockorange 'Minnesota Snowflake'	An order consists of 2, 18"-24" seedlings. Minnesota Snowflake Mockorange is a large, rounded shrub with delightfully, large double white flowers in early summer that that are wonderful in bloom. It is a low maintenance shrub that has a mature height of 8' and spread of 6'.
Deciduous Azaleas (<i>Pentantha</i>)	An order consists of one Deciduous Azalea plant" in a one-gallon pot. You pick your color choice of Red, White Pink or Yellow. They are shrubs with long leading branches, attractive green foliage and brilliant colorful flowers in late spring and summer. Deciduous Azaleas lose their leaves in Autumn and Winter. Grown best in part sun, they will tolerate full sun if kept slightly moist, otherwise an acidic, well-drained soil is preferred. Grown locally.
Butterfly & Hummingbird Garden seed mix	Seed mixture is of native and naturalized wildflowers and grasses designed to attract nectar-loving pollinators such as native bees, insects and hummingbirds. Mixture is ERNMX-179. Majority of mix reaches 3-4 feet at maturity. Seed coverage : 7-10 pounds per acre; 1 ounce per 388 sq. ft.
