<b>Apple Trees</b> <i>(Malus domestica)**</i>	An order consists of one "Liberty" and one "Enterprise" Apple tree. The trees are bare root whips which are approximately 4' to 5' tall. Liberty is a medium sized, yellow-fleshed dessert apple with 90% red over yellow background color. It is resistant to apple scab, cedar apple rust, fire blight and mildew. Rootstock is G-969. Enterprise is a late-maturing, deep red apple with good keeping qualities. Fruit is uniform & medium to large size. It is highly resistant to fire blight and cedar apple rust. Root stock is EMLA 7. Both are trees are vigorous, spreading and have good annual bearing habits. Anchoring both of these trees will be beneficial.
<b>Peach Tree</b> <i>(Prunus persica)</i>	An order consists of ONE "John Boy®" Peach tree. This peach has now claimed a prominent status as commercial peach variety. The fruit is of very high quality, ripening 10-14 days before Loring with better color. Trees are vigorous & productive with good resistant to bacterial leaf spot. They are self-fertile & do not require cross pollination.
<b>Plum Tree</b> <i>(Prunus)</i>	An order consists of ONE "Methley" Plum tree. It is self-fertile and an early plum with fine quality & appearance. The fruit is purple with red, sweet flesh and very juicy with distinctive flavor. Ripening in early to mid-July.
<b>Blueberry Bushes</b> <i>(Vaccinium)**</i>	An order consists of one "Chanticleer" (Early) and one "Draper" (Mid-Late) blueberry bush obtained from a local berry farm. Plants are of bearing age and with care, will develop large flavorful berries. Select a sunny, well-drained site with sandy or loamy soil. You may need to add soil amendments. Each variety is in a 1-gallon pot.
<b>Strawberry Plants</b> <i>(Fragaria)</i>	An order consists of 25 strawberry vine plugs. The flavorful variety is "Seascape" a productive day-neutral variety. Highly successful for Northeastern growers for summer and fall production. Seascape will flower and fruit all season. The berries are large, prolific, and have good flavor when picked ripe.
<b>Pin Oak</b> <i>(Quercus palustris)</i>	An order consists of 5, seedlings ranging in height from 18-24 inches. The best-known oak for street and ornamental planting. Forms a symmetrical pyramidal head with drooping branches. Beautiful green foliage of leaves 3" to 5" wide with five pointed lobes, bright green leaves turning yellow to radiant red in Autumn. Prefers somewhat moist soil. A fast-growing tree with light to dark grayish-brown bark. Mature height of 75 to 80 feet
<b>Concolor Fir</b> <i>(Abies concolor)</i>	An order consists of 5, 2-year seedlings, 2-0, ranging in height from 4-8 inches. They are a beautiful evergreen with flat, varying soft green to deep blue needles. A very hardy tree growing in a variety of well-drained soils, standing dryness and high temperatures better than other firs. Rapid grower after becoming established. A beautiful ornamental specimen, windbreak or colorful screen.
<b>American Arborvitae</b> <i>(Thuja occidentalis)</i>	An order consists of 5, 2year Seedlings ranging in height from 3-6 inches. A handsome pyramidal evergreen with foliage varying from dark green to light green during the growing season. Very hardy, easily transplanted evergreen that grows well in a variety of soils but best in loamy, moist soil. Excellent for screens or tall hedges.
<b>Mini Cosmo Flowers</b>	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. These plants are a miniature version of Cosmos. They are part of the Asteraceae Family, which includes daisies, sunflowers and asters. Colors vary. Beautiful flowers that attract bees, butterflies and birds. Easy to grow & Low maintenance. Pest & disease resistance.
<b>Dianthus Flowers</b>	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Dianthus are a perennial flower that blooms in late spring-summer. They are enjoyed for their silvery-green foliage and showy fragrant flowers varying in colors. A favorite of butterflies for the nectar rich blooms. They are also deer resistant.
<b>Impatien Flowers</b>	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Impatiens are a beautiful annual flower that will bloom from late spring until early frost. The variety of color that Impatiens will add to your garden will attract butterflies and hummingbirds.
<b>Deciduous Azaleas</b> <i>(Pentathera)</i>	An order consists of one, "Deciduous Azalea plant" in a one-gallon pot. You pick your color choice of Red, White Pink or Yellow. They are shrubs with long leading branches, attractive green foliage and brilliant colorful flowers in late spring and summer. Deciduous Azaleas lose their leaves in Autumn and Winter. Grown best in part sun, they will tolerate full sun if kept slightly moist, otherwise an acidic, well-drained soil is preferred. Grown locally.
<b>Northeast Annual &amp; Perennial Wildflower Mix</b>	Seed mixture is very colorful mix that provides up to 5 years of color & attracts a variety of birds and butterflies. Mixture is ERNMX-168. Majority of mix reaches 2-5 feet at maturity. Seed coverage: 7-10lbs per acre; 1oz per 388 sq. ft.
