Apple Trees <i>(Malus domestica)**</i>	An order consists of one "Fuji" and one "Golden Delicious" Apple tree. The trees are bare root whips that are approximately 4' to 5' tall. Fuji is a medium-large, sweet fruit with a pink-red blush over 80% of the fruit surface. Rootstock is G-890. Golden Delicious is one of the most widely planted apple cultivators worldwide. Fruit is firm, medium to large with the classic Golden Delicious flavor. Root stock is G-935. Both are trees are spreading, productive and easy to manage. Fruit thinning is required to maintain annual bearing.
Peach Tree <i>(Prunus persica)</i>	An order consists of ONE "Redhaven" Peach tree. This peach variety is considered by many as the standard for the Northeast peach variety. Fruit is medium-sized and colors to a brilliant red. One of the best commercial varieties. Trees are vigorous, very bud-hardy and productive. Self-fertile & do not require cross pollination.
Blueberry Bushes <i>(Vaccinium)**</i>	An order consists of one "Chanticleer" (Early) and one "Draper" (Mid-Late) blueberry bush obtained from a local berry farm. Plants are of bearing age and with care, will develop large flavorful berries. Select a sunny, well-drained site with sandy or loamy soil. You may need to add soil amendments. Each variety is in a 1-gallon pot.
Strawberry Plants <i>(Fragaria)</i>	An order consists of 25 strawberry vine plugs. The flavorful variety is "Seascape" a productive day-neutral strawberry. Highly successful for Northeastern growers for summer and fall production. Seascape will flower and fruit all season. The berries are large, prolific, and have good flavor when picked ripe.
Paw Paw Trees <i>(Asimina triloba)</i>	An order consists of 5, 6–12-inch seedlings. A deciduous, often narrow conical tree growing 12-25 feet tall with dark green leaves that can grow up to 12" in length. The Paw paw fruit is an oblong shaped fruit, light green in color, weighing 5-16 ounces and 3-6 inches in length. The inside has a creamy, custard texture varying in color from creamy-white to yellow-orange. The taste is described as a cross between a mango and a banana. Plant at least 2 trees for fruit production to ensure cross pollination.
Chestnut Oak Trees <i>(Quercus prinus)</i>	An order consists of 5 seedlings, ranging in height from 6-12 inches. One of Pennsylvania's native oak trees, growing in height from 50 to 60 feet. Also known as Rock oak. It is a member of the White Oak group and prefers drier rocky soil. Can be used for windbreaks, reforestations and a good food source for wildlife.
Scotch Pine (<i>Pinus sylvestris</i>)	An order consists of 5, 3-year seedlings ranging in height from 12-24 inches. Species is French Noble. Easily transplanted. A beautiful evergreen with rigid, blueish-green needles. One of the fastest growing of the pine family. A vigorous-growing hardy plant that adjusts itself to dry soils. Excellent for Christmas trees or landscape.
Marigold Flowers	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Marigolds are annual flowers of the Aster family. They are very colorful ranging from a bright orange, yellow or red composite flower. Often planted in gardens to attract pollinators and their fragrant leaves are used to deter pests in vegetable gardens. Deer resistant.
Zinnia Flowers	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Zinnia flowers are within the Asteraceae family. They have assorted brightly colored, round daisy-like blossoms. They bloom from springtime to autumn.
Dianthus Flowers	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Dianthus are a perennial flower that blooms in late spring-summer. They are enjoyed for their silvery-green foliage and showy fragrant flowers varying in color. A favorite of butterflies for their nectar-rich blooms. They are also deer resistant.
Mini Cosmo Flowers	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. These plants are a miniature version of Cosmos. They are part of the Asteraceae Family, which includes daisies, sunflowers and asters. Colors vary. Beautiful flowers that attract bees, butterflies and birds. Easy to grow & low maintenance. Pest & disease resistance.
Mountain Laurel	An order consists of 1 three-gallon potted Mountain Laurel. Grown locally. Mountain Laurel is native to the Eastern United States and is the state flower for Pennsylvania. Varieties range. Flowers are a beautiful pink-white. Best suited for hedge plant, garden border or just a landscape accent.
Northeast Annual & Perennial Wildflower Mix	Seed mixture is a very colorful mix that provides up to 5 years of color & attracts a variety of birds and butterflies. Mixture is ERNMX-168. Majority of mix reaches 2-5 feet at maturity. Seed coverage: 7-10lbs per acre; 1oz per 388 sq. ft.
