Apple Trees <i>(Malus domestica)**</i>	An order consists of ONE "Honeycrisp" and ONE "Cortland" Apple tree. The trees are bare root whips that are approximately 4' to 5' tall. This Honeycrisp is a popular variety developed at the University of Minnesota (MN1711). It is a crisp, juicy, sweet-tart apple with a rich flavor making it "#1" in taste panels. Has outstanding winter hardiness making it great for northern growing regions & is moderately resistant to apple scab. Cortland is a cross between McIntosh & Ben Davis. Fruit is very large, beautiful red, with a pure white flesh. Crops are heavier than most and considered an annual bearer. Both varieties are Rootstock EMLA-7.
Peach Tree <i>(Prunus persica)</i>	An order consists of ONE "Starfire" Peach tree. This peach variety is considered a promising variety from the Steller® series. Fruit is brilliant red, very firm with excellent quality. The tree is winter hardy, productive and highly tolerant to bacterial spot. The rootstock is Bailey. Self-fertile & does not require cross pollination.
Nectarine Tree <i>(Prunus persica var.)</i>	An order consists of ONE "Redgold" Nectarine tree. The fruit is a large-sized, yellow fleshed, very attractive, red nectarine. Trees are self-fertile, vigorous and productive. Cross pollination is not required. Rootstock is Lovell.
Blueberry Bushes <i>(Vaccinium)**</i>	An order consists of ONE "Sweetheart" (Very-Early) and ONE "Talisman" (Late) blueberry bush obtained from a local berry farm. Plants are of bearing age & with care, will develop large flavorful berries. Select a sunny, well-drained site with sandy or loamy soil. You may need to add soil amendments. Each species is in a 1-gallon pot.
Strawberry Plants <i>(Fragaria)</i>	An order consists of 25 strawberry vine plugs. The flavorful variety is "Seascape," a productive day-neutral strawberry. Highly successful for Northeastern growers for summer and fall production. Seascape will flower and fruit all season. The berries are large, prolific, and have good flavor when picked ripe.
Persimmon Trees <i>(Diospyros virginiana)**</i>	An order consists of five Common Persimmon seedlings ranging in height from 18-24 inches. Persimmons are a native tree growing from 25-40 feet in height and 20-35 feet in width. Trees produce white, fragrant flowers that are very sweet and a favorite of honeybees in spring to yield an orange edible fruit in the fall that ripens after several frosts. More than one tree is needed for pollination to produce fruit.
Red Cedar Trees <i>(Juniperus virginiana)</i>	An order consists of 5, 1-year seedlings ranging in height from 4-8 inches. Being a juniper and not a true cedar, leaves are narrow, 1/16" to 1" long, dark green, scale-like and compressed to form a four-sided branchlet. By autumn, dark blue, fleshy, highly aromatic, berry-like cones develop, which are food for birds and small mammals. Grows well in a variety of soils in full sun. Tolerates wet soils. Good for dense windbreaks.
Douglas Fir Trees <i>(Pseudotsuga menziesii glauca)</i>	An order consists of 5, 4-year transplants ranging in height from 12-24 inches. Variety is Lincoln N.F. Douglas Fir is a splendid pyramidal evergreen conifer, with short stalked flat, dark green or bluish-green needles, 3/4" to 1-1/4" long. Bears cones at maturity 2"-4" long. A rapid growing, hardy tree that grows well in a variety of soils. It is a good blue strain which buds late. A beautiful Christmas tree, a lovely ornamental, or windbreak.
Tulip Poplar Trees <i>(Liriodendron tulipifera)</i>	An order consists of 5, Tulip Poplar seedlings ranging in height from 18-24 inches. It is a hardy ornamental and forest tree also known as Yellow Poplar. Pyramidal form with light green glossy leaves and greenish yellow tulip-shaped flowers. Grows to about 80-100 feet. Tolerant to pollution. Recommended for reforestation.
Spicebush Shrubs <i>(Lindera benzoin)</i>	An order consists of 5 Spicebush seedlings ranging in height from 18-24 inches. Also known as allspice, grows to 15 feet, producing a berry ripening in August and September which is eaten by game birds.
Begonia Flowers <i>(Begonia x semperflorens)</i>	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. This variety is Ambassador mix that are annual, free-flowing plants that perform equally well in garden beds, mixed containers and hanging baskets. They have lush green foliage & vibrant blooms that continue to bloom in hot & humid conditions. Low maintenance, drought/shade tolerant.
Dusty Miller Flowers <i>(Senecio cineraria)</i>	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. Dusty Miller is an annual flowering shrub that produces clusters of small yellow daisy-like flowers. The plant is identified by its silvery lobed leaves that have fine hairs and yellow flowers. Most gardeners remove the flowers to boost foliage growth. Best grown in full sun or partial shade.
Petunia Flowers	An order consists of 4 potted seedling plants. This variety of Petunias is the Wave Petunia. They are an annual flower that can be used in planters and gardens. They are carefree and spread vigorously to offer an extended bloom time. They don't require constant deadheading and are extremely resistant to pests and diseases.
Northeast Annual & Perennial Wildflower Mix	Seed mixture is a very colorful mix that provides up to 5 years of color & attracts a variety of birds & butterflies. Mixture is ERNMX-168. Majority of mix reaches 2'-5' at maturity. Seed coverage: 7-10lbs per acre; 1oz per 388sf.
